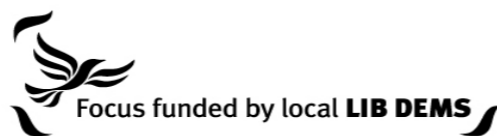

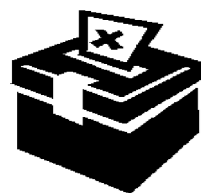
SNIPPETS

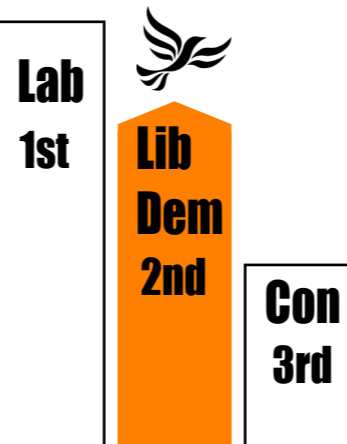
STANDING UP FOR THE NORTH EAST IN EUROPE
