Preston Park Our Campaign Goes On

Liberal Democrat Councillors were dismayed to hear Stockton Council's Labour/Tory cabinet agree to spend about £40,000 of Council Tax Payers' money on looking at whether to rebuild Eggescliffe School in Preston Park.

Many of you signed the Liberal Democrat petition **Hands Off Preston Park**. You said you wanted to be able to go and walk in the Park and take your children to play there.

The Labour Cabinet member responsible said "Nothing will be done to compromise Preston Park"

BUT then he proposed spending your money on finding out if the Park could be built on, his Tory friends in the cabinet agreed with him and his Labour colleagues, so it goes ahead.

The Preston Park proposal would take all the Quarry Rd Allotments, all the top South field, (overflow carpark) and a large part of the field from there down to the river beside Quarry Wood. There is no money yet for the school, and no promise of any government money, but we want to nip this suggestion in the bud.
