MILE HOUSE JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS

I am writing to inform you that we intend to start reconstruction of a section of the A177 Durham Road, part of Darlington Lane and replacement of the existing traffic signals at the intersection of these two roads near the Mile House Hotel on 25th June 2007.

From 25th June Darlington Lane will be closed to traffic between the Access to Coral Bookmakers/Mile House Hotel and Durham Road for approximately 6 weeks. Traffic wanting to cross Durham Road to the 'Bell's Stores' side of the junction should approach the area by travelling southwards on Durham Road.

Following this, for approx another 6 weeks, traffic will be restricted to a 'left turn only' movement from Darlington Lane onto Durham Road and should then follow the Diversion signs. See below.

For the duration of the works Northbound traffic on the A177 Durham Road will be diverted from it's junction with the roundabout on the A1027 Ring Road via the A1027 Ring Road towards Norton and back along Junction Road to the roundabout near Tesco. Southbound traffic on the A177 Durham Road will be maintained throughout the duration of the works.

The works have been split into 4 main stages of construction each of which necessitate various traffic restriction movements around the junction area. For the duration of the works temporary traffic signals will replace the existing traffic signals. The Roadworks contractor is required to maintain pedestrian footways but some crossings will need to be relocated away from the working area.
