MILE HOUSE JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS

I am writing to inform you that we intend to start reconstruction of a section of the A177 Durham Road, part of Darlington Lane and replacement of the existing traffic signals at the intersection of these two roads near the Mile House Hotel on 25th June 2007. The extent of the works are outlined on the attached sketch (drawing number TS/D1/25/1/101, printed at A4 size for manageability) and are programmed to last 12 weeks.

For the duration of the works Northbound traffic on the A177 Durham Road will be diverted from it's junction with the roundabout on the A1027 Ring Road via the A1027 Ring Road towards Norton and back along Junction Road to the roundabout near Tesco. Southbound traffic on the A177 Durham Road will be maintained throughout the duration of the works.

Access to properties on Durham Road to the south side of it's junction with Darlington Lane will be maintained at all times from the roundabout on the A1027. No northbound access onto Darlington Lane and northwards of the junction will be available for the duration of the works. Buses travelling northbound will be diverted via Durham Road -> A1027 Ring Road -> Darlington Lane -> Ragpath Lane -> Redhill Road -> Durham Road.

The works have been split into 4 main stages of construction each of which necessitate various traffic restriction movements around the junction area. These are shown on the attached drawing numbers TS/D1/25/8/101 to TS/D1/25/8/103 inclusive (printed at A4 size for manageability). For the duration of the works temporary traffic signals will replace the existing traffic signals. The Roadworks contractor is required to maintain pedestrian footways but some crossings will need to be relocated away from the working area.
