Proposed closure of Urlay Nook Level Crossing

We are considering applying for an order to permanently close the railway level crossing at Urlay Nook Road (indicated by 'A' on the map on reverse).

If the order proceeds, as part of the works, a new roundabout is proposed at the junction of the A67 and Urlay Nook Road ('D' on the map) and minor road modifications at the junction of Long Newton Lane and Urlay Nook Road ('E' on the map). The proposed diversion with indicative distances has also been indicated on the map.

As part of the exercise, not only are we seeking the views of the Highway Authority and local businesses, but we also seek comments from other parties who may be affected. As we consider that you may be affected by the proposal, we would therefore appreciate your comments.

We would be grateful if you could kindly either email or write to us at the above address with your views and include your name and address.

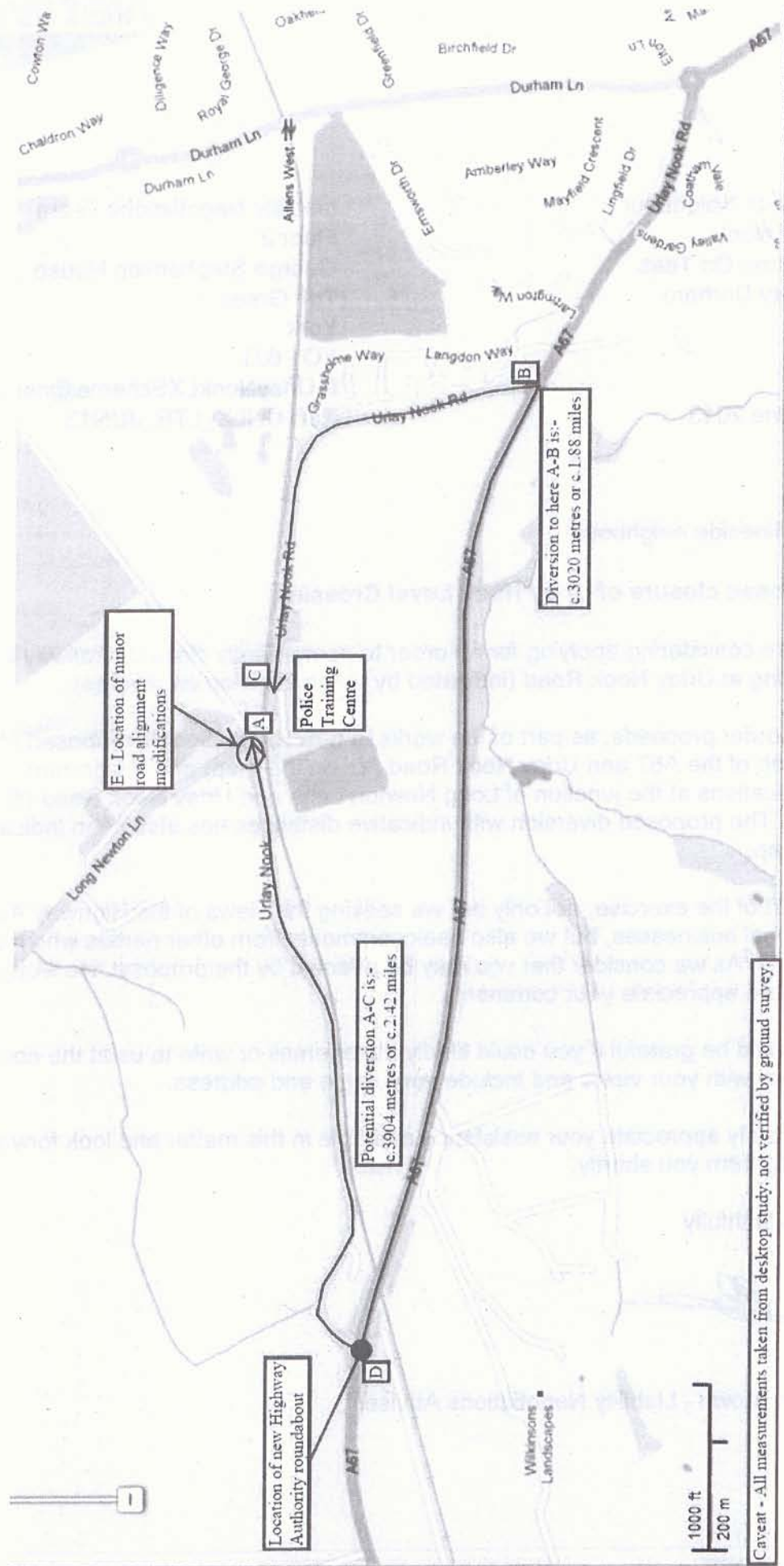
